
® Why You're Here

If Google can't see your site, no one can. Follow every step. Miss one and stay invisible.

Do the Work

1 — Verify the Domain (No Verification = No Site)

- 1. Open Google Search Console.
- 2. Pick **Domain** (covers every subdomain + protocol).
- 3. Copy the TXT record Google spits out.
- 4. Paste it in your DNS zone. Save. Wait.
- 5. Hit **Verify**. If it fails, wait a few minutes and hit **Verify** again.




A Skip this and everything else is wasted.

Stop here if your site isn't live yet.

The next steps only work once your domain points to a working site. If you're not there yet, you're not ready for this. Finish setup first, then come back.


2 — Submit Your Sitemap (Tell Google What to Crawl)

- 1. GSC > Sitemaps.
- Enter/sitemap.xmlor/sitemap_index.xml.
- 3. **Submit**. Red error? Your sitemap plugin's broken. Fix it.




✓ 3 — Inspect Critical Pages

Paste a URL in **URL Inspection** \rightarrow if Google says *Not Indexed*, smash **Request Indexing**. Run this on: homepage, service pages, blog landers. Anything that makes money.




4 — Watch the Numbers (Performance)

GSC → **Performance** → Track **Clicks**, **Impressions**, **CTR**, **Avg Position**. Ignore everything else. Drops = fix content or links, not vibes.




5 — Page Experience & Enhancements (Fix the Tech)

- **Page Experience**: Slow, insecure, or mobile-broken pages bleed rank.
- **Enhancements**: Resolve schema / structured-data errors.




✓ 6 — Penalties & Links (Survival Check)

- Manual Actions: 0 or GTFO. Fix whatever shows.
- **Links**: External = authority. Internal = flow. Build both.



√ 7 — Add/Remove Users (Only If You Trust Them)

- 1. Settings > Users & Permissions
- 2. **Add User** \rightarrow email \rightarrow Full or Restricted.
- 3. Revoke access when work is done.
